"Steps To Take To Minimize Post-Restorative Complications With Dental Implants"

Summary - With approximately 2 million dental implants placed annually, there is a rapidly growing population of dental implants with issues. This brief 15 minute course will help with the diagnosis of peri-implant mucositis/peri-implantitis, treatment and maintenance of dental implants.
