Polk County Dental Association hosts "Barn Raiser - Volunteer Dental Referral Software Program" By Dr. Leo Cullinan Tuesday, November 19th, 2013

There was a time in rural America that if your neighbor's barn burned to the ground everyone in the community would gather and rebuild that barn...they called it a "Barn Raiser". Providing pro-bono dental services for the underserved in our communities is no different a process. It takes a willingness on the part of the Dental Professionals and the Community to empathize and help out those in need..."Raise their Barn"!

In 2008, the Dental Referral Program of the Neighborhood Health Clinic in Naples, Florida was formed to screen underserved patients at the clinic, identify their chief dental concern, and refer them to private offices for dental treatment. While the treatment was fairly straightforward, the administrative challenges were onerous and not conducive to sustaining a viable program.

The *Barn Raiser* Volunteer Dental Referral Software Program was born out of that experience and designed to address those administrative challenges. We operated under one simple premise-*make it easy* to:

- 1. Refer the patient to a private office,
- 2. effectively communicate with the volunteer providers,
- 3. schedule the needed treatment in a timely manner,
- 4. document the treatment and value of services, and ultimately develop a more equitable system of referral so that "carrying the "load" doesn't just fall on the shoulders of a few good Samaritans.

Dr. Leo R. Cullinan will present an overview and tutorial of his "Barn Raiser Volunteer Dental Referral Software Program & Process" at the November 19th dinner meeting of the Polk County Dental Association.

The Barn Raiser Software program is physically hosted on one of Dr. Cullinan's web servers, is easy to use for even the most novice of computer users, is a web-based application, and can be accessed 24/7 from any location with internet access. The program is HIPAA compliant. The use of this proprietary software by the Polk County Dental Association and its Professional Volunteers is free. (Dr. Cullinan will, however, always accept any donation made to his non-profit, Dental Outreach of Collier, Inc. (DOC) (501c(3))

We will celebrate this day on February 7th, 2014 at Traviss Career Center. However, if any other office is willing to host the event too, please let me know as the scheduling will all be handled through the school. There is always additional sites to include the Winter Haven, Haines City area, or alternate days needed for parents of children unable to make the trek to Lakeland due to transportation constraints.

We ask that you all bring your favorite toys and restorative materials for the day otherwise we will work with what is available at the school. Please invite your hygienists and assistants to join us as well. Traviss students will be available but, will also be assigned to escort the children to treatment areas as well as assist you and your assistant in turning over the chairs and retrieving supplies needed. The hygienists are needed to man the hygiene/toothbrush prophy/fluoride OHI lab as well as the occasional "jump in the chair to scale or operate the cavitron." The Traviss crew will all be wearing the t-shirts in order to be recognized as GKAS volunteers, to offer assistance to either the dental staffs in attendance or to the parents and the children.

Again, we need endodontists, oral surgeons and possibly periodontists to accept referrals from this event either that day or quickly thereafter. Let Susan know and the volunteer general dentists will be given your name for referring those patients in need of specialty services.
